Like a shot of good Irish Whiskey, when the Malarkey Brothers start in, it's the real stuff. Straight up! And 'twould likely to compel you to jump up to dance, to muse upon the past ... perhaps dream of the future. You're bound like it! And if your toe starts a-tappin', don't hold back. Just let 'er go!!!
